1. Please have all applications and fees returned to the **MOWA Choctaw Tribal Office** or a **Pow-Wow Committee member** by **Friday, September 23, 2022 at 6:30 pm**
2. The entry fee is \$50.00 and it is non-refundable
3. The first meeting and practice will be on **Sunday, September 25, 2022 at 3:00 pm** at the tribal pow-wow grounds
4. Please make every effort to attend each meeting
5. During pageant contestants will complete the following:
 - Interview with judges
 - Extend greeting in Choctaw
 - Perform talent
 - Exhibition dance (grand entry and individual)
6. All contestants will be asked to sell raffle tickets
7. The **actual pageant** will be held on **Thursday, September 29, 2022 at 7:00pm**
8. Winners will be announced on **Friday, September 30, 2022** after the **7:00pm Grand Entry**
9. Winners will receive a crown, trophy, and sash.
10. Winners will be responsible for the crowns. If not returned in the same condition as received then the parents of the Princess will be responsible for replacing the crown.
11. Princesses will be expected to volunteer to represent the tribe at events.
12. All participants must wear Choctaw traditional regalia.

Tiny Tot and Mother of the Tribe information below

1. All money and applications for applicants running for Tiny Tot Princess and Mother of the Tribe need to be turned in on **Thursday, September 29th, 2022 by 7:00pm** to the **Pow-Wow Committee. The committee will count money at the tribal office at that time.**
2. The Tiny Tot Princess candidate who raises the most money, must raise a minimum of \$1000 to keep the crown.
3. The Mother of the Tribe candidate who raises the most money, must raise a minimum of \$1000 to keep the crown.
4. Winners will be announced on **Friday, September 30, 2022** after the **7:00pm Grand Entry**
5. The entry fee is \$50.00 due at the time the money raised is due and it is non-refundable
6. Winners will receive a crown, trophy, and sash.
7. Winners will be responsible for the crowns. If not returned in the same condition as received then they will be responsible for replacing the crown.
8. Princesses will be expected to volunteer to represent the tribe at events when ask to
9. All participants must wear Choctaw traditional regalia.
